



## Leningrad region Tours.

### **Petrokrepost (Shlusselburg)** ( 65 km from St.Petersburg)

One a large island Horders at the outflow of the full-watered Neva from Lake Ladoga people of Novgorod built a strong fortress. This first Russian multitowered fortification took part in military actions more than once. During World War II the garnison of the fortress held back the enemy for three years

### **Staraya Ladoga.**

( 130 km from St.Petersburg)

This is the oldest town of the region, it is located on the Volkhov river flowing to Novgorod.

The town existed even at the beginning of the Viking epoch in the 8<sup>th</sup> century as a trade center on the famous waterway "from Varangians to the Greeks". Three strong towers rise at the ends of a promontory formed by the Volkhov and Ladozhka rivulet

Two old churches have stood here for ages. A wonderful panorama view opens on the fortress and a few monasteries along the Volkhov banks.
